Mr. John J. Bross, Jr., age 82, of Dunmore, died Saturday evening at Mercy Hospital in Scranton. Born in Mahanoy City, he was the son of the late John J. and Nora (Ryan) Bross. He was a 1944 graduate of Mahanoy City High School where he served as class president. He also graduated from McCann School of Business and attended Franklin and Marshall College in Lancaster. He served with the U.S. Navy during WW II. He worked for and retired from RCA. For 20 years, he worked in financial operations at the RCA plant in Lancaster and then transferred to Dunmore where he was manager of facility planning.
