Ada Cauler Fridy, of Luther Care, formerly of Columbia, who would have celebrated her 100th birthday on Tuesday, August 12, 2008, died, Tuesday, August 5, 2008 at Ephrata Community Hospital of natural causes. She was the wife of the late Charles B. Fridy, Jr. for 46 years until his death in 1994. She was born in Lancaster, daughter of the late William L. and Mary Benedick Cauler. She graduated from Millersville Normal School, Class of 1926, and then went on to teach at Freemont School, which is now called Lafayette, Lancaster. When WWII started, she decided that if she enlisted, there would be one less family man who would have to go. She served in the Women's Army Air Corp (WAC) and eventually rose to the rank of Lieutenant. Ada served as a chauffeur during the war. When she came back, she worked for the Pennsylvania State Employment Office for 34 years before retiring in 1969. Having no children of her own, her lifelong effort was advising and helping family members and friends. She will be greatly missed by her family. She was the last of her immediate family having all of her seven brothers and sisters precede her in death. A member of Columbia Presbyterian Church.
