



John H. Myers, D.D.S.

John H. Myers, D.D.S., 96, beloved husband of Thelma Krajeski Myers, died Thursday, November 13, 2008 at Lancaster General Hospital. Born in Pittsburgh, he was the son of the Harry E. and Myrtle McCall Myers.

Dr. Myers spent most of his adult life in Yeadon in Delaware County, Hershey's Mill in West Chester and Willow Valley Retirement Community in Lancaster County, as well as summers at Kentmore Park, MD and winters at Ft. Myers Beach, FL.

He graduated cum laude from Temple University Dental School and was inducted into the national dental honorary society, Omicron Kappa Upsilon. He interned at Temple University Hospital in Philadelphia from 1937-1938. Dr. Myers practiced dentistry for 43 years in Philadelphia and Yeadon, retiring in 1980.

During World War II he served as a Lieutenant in the U.S. Navy stationed first at Sampson Naval Center in NY and then on the U.S.S. Missoula, APA 211 in the Pacific.

Very active throughout his life, he helped to found the social fraternity Kappa Alpha Gamma in high school. Dr. Myers served as president of the Yeadon Professional Club, Commodore of Kentmore Park Sailing Club and board member of Kentmore Park Improvement Association. Dr. Myers also served as an ordained Elder of Yeadon Presbyterian Church and as a member of the Hamilton Lodge Masons. After retirement he volunteered for the American Red Cross and as a resident council member at Willow Valley Retirement Community.

Dr. Myers hobbies included tennis, golf, sail boat racing, and fishing as well as building and flying model airplanes. He also played the piano and organ. He was a member of Willow Street United Church of Christ in Willow Street, PA.

Dr. Myers is survived by his loving wife of 70 years, Thelma; his children Joan (Myers) and Allan Maybee of Camp Hill, PA and Dr. John and Rosemary Myers of Kentmore Park, MD; his grandchildren Scott Maybee, John Louis and Megin Myers, Rebecca and Dan Hamilton, and Julie Zang; and great grandchildren Alison, Travis, Chloe, Jack and Chase.
