

Eugene F. Paules Dover

Eugene F. Paules, 84, formerly of Mountville, entered into God's loving care 2:50 a.m. Sunday, October 26, 2008 at Rest Haven ' York. He was the loving husband of AnnaLee (Livingston) Paules for 61 years. They were married on August 2, 1947 by Rev. Roy W. Limbert.

He was born November 19, 1923 in Dover, a son of the late Earl M. and Annie V. (Bentzel) Paules.

Eugene graduated from Dover High School in 1941.

He proudly served as Staff Sergeant in the U.S. Army Air Force during World War II from 1943-1945. Eugene flew in B25's and A26's in 107 missions as a tailgunner in the Normandy, Northern France, Rhineland, and Air Offensive Europe Campaigns. He received the European-African-Middle Eastern Service Medal with four bronze stars and the Good Conduct Medal.

He had worked for Nolt Ponds, Lancaster and previously for Atlantic Breeders, Lancaster.

Eugene was a member of Salem United Church of Christ, Rohrerstown and a former member of Dover United Church of Christ, Dover. He was a life member of West Manchester Township VFW Post #7374 and a member of Garden Spot American Legion Post #0056. He was also a member of Jacob Joner Council, No. 60, Jr. O.U.A.M.; Dover Area Ambulance Club; Union Fire & Hose Co. #1, Dover; and AARP. He enjoyed listening to the 'Big Band' music of the 1940's.

In addition to his wife, Eugene is survived by numerous nieces and nephews.
