

Miss Martin, Teacher, Dies

Miss Martha Martin, 85, a teacher of religion at Elizabethtown College for 34 years, and a former resident of Elizabethtown, died Tuesday at the Neffsville Brethren Home, after a short illness.

Born in Goodville, she was a daughter of the late Aaron and Lydia Martzall Martin. She was a member of the Elizabethtown Church of the Brethren and taught the Women's Bible Class.

Miss Martin was graduated from Elizabethtown College in 1924 and began her teaching career there the same year. She did postgraduate work at Dr. White's Biblical Seminary, New York City, Bethany Bible Seminary, and the University of Pennsylvania.

During her career, she taught Biblical history, Bible literature, Teachings of Jesus, Apostolic Christianity, Bible Doctrine and Religious Education.

In 1954, she was presented with a 50-year service medal by the Lancaster County Sunday School Convention for her years teaching Sunday School at her church.

She is survived by two nephews.
