



Eleven mallard ducklings escaped death Saturday afternoon when they were rescued from inside a storm drain in front of the Babies 'R' Us on Plaza Boulevard in Manheim Township.

They were saved by a staff member from the Organization for Responsible Care of Animals after a caller phoned in about the stranded ducklings at around 4 p.m. Saturday.

"It happens all the time during this time of year," ORCA wildlife specialist Sandra Mays

She said that this was the fourth time ducklings had to be rescued from a storm drain last week. Tuesday, ORCA staff rescued 30 stranded ducklings in three separate incidents.

The Saturday rescue went off without a hitch. The 11 ducklings were reunited with their mother and sent back into the wild.

"This was a pretty decent situation because it was in a parking lot," Mays said. "A lot of times it's in the street, and you have to worry about your own safety and the mother's."
