Barket A. Haddad, 87, of Lancaster, entered into rest on Friday, July 4, 2008 at Lancashire Hall.

Born July 22, 1920, in Greensburg, PA, he was the son of the late Anies T. and Bertha (Halout) Haddad. He was married to Jamely (Nadur) Haddad for close to 54 years.

A Graduate of the Green Briar Military Academy, in WV, he received a B.A. from

the University of Pittsburgh, and was doing graduate work at the University of Miami, when his father died, and was called back to manage the family business, Haddad Shoe Corporation in Lancaster.

A Veteran of WWII, Barket proudly served with the U.S. Army where he was stationed in North Africa. He was a member of the Masons and Elks in Lancaster, the West Lancaster Ambulance Crew, the Lancaster County Republican Committee, and a member of the First Assembly of God Church, in Lancaster.
