Paul E. Manning, 75, of Millersville, PA, formerly a long time resident of North Andover, MA, died September 2 following a brief illness. Born in South Boston, MA, he was the son of the late Francis J. Manning and Irene (Reidy) Manning. He was the devoted husband of the late J. Joyce (Balsamo) Manning, who preceded him in death in 1971.

Paul served in the U.S. Air Force from 1951 to 1955 and was a graduate of Northeastern University with BS and MS in Physics. He worked with several
