Olive Blackburn, 97, passed away September 18, 2008, at her home at the Vista at Mission Ridge in Billings, Montana.

She was born April 10, 1911 in Manheim, Pennsylvania, the daughter of Howard and Emma (Erb) Ritter. She received her degree from Westchester State Teachers College.
