Robert W. Eno, Jr., 81, of Marietta, died Sunday, October 26. He was the loving husband of Minerva A. Leese Eno and they celebrated thirty-one years of marriage this past August 27. Born in West Chester, PA, Bob was the son of the late Robert W. Sr. and Rachel Quintin Eno, and was raised on a dairy farm in Wayne County where he became a member of the Dairyman's Association. He was a pilot for 33 years, a Colonel-Retired, from the USAF and PAANG.
