

Gerald A. Krushinsky



Gerald A. Krushinsky, 87, of Lancaster, died Wednesday, July 17, 2013 at LRMC. He was the husband of the late Erika (Resch) Krushinsky, who died in 2006.

Gerald had worked as a manager for Armstrong World Industries until his retirement in 1989. He and his late wife had operated J.K. Antiques on North Prince Street and also operated stands at Renninger's and the Black Angus, both in Adamstown.

Born January 18, 1926 in Lancaster, he was the son of the late Leon J. and M. Anna (Martin) Krushinsky. Gerald was a member of Sacred Heart of Jesus Catholic Church, Lancaster. A Purple Heart Veteran of WWII, he served in the U. S. Army in Europe where he was wounded on December 24, 1944 in Northern France.
