



Reverend Ormond L. Hampton, Jr.

The Reverend Ormond L. Hampton, Jr., N. Fort Myers, FL, passed away on July 24, 2008. He was born May 9, 1927 in Wilmington, DE, son of O.L. Hampton, Sr., and Emma E. Hampton.

The Rev. Hampton graduated from Manheim Township High School in 1945 and was drafted into the Army in the same year. He served in the European Theater as a non-commissioned officer in charge of the G-2 Interrogations Section in Frankfurt, Germany.

After his active service in the Army, he graduated from Franklin and Marshall College in 1950 with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in History. He then married Nancy LeFever. The Hamptons moved to Princeton, NJ where the Rev. Hampton graduated from Princeton Theological Seminary with a Master's of Divinity Degree, following which he was Ordained into the Presbyterian Ministry.

In the Presbyterian Church U.S.A., he served on various Presbytery and Synod committees, dean of several Synod leadership schools, and commissioner to several General Assemblies. Following his retirement he served six churches as interim pastor, most recently the Honey Brook Presbyterian Church in PA (his parents' home church).

Surviving him are his wife, Nancy L. Hampton, sons Thomas I. Hampton of San Diego, CA, Timothy A. Hampton of N. Fort Myers, FL and daughter Mrs. John (Holly) Dercola of Atlanta, GA, five grandsons and one Great grandson.
