

Natural Drainage Notes:  
Where soil is undisturbed and vegetated there is no evidence of concentrated surface water running openly in wet weather, as the modest grade and the porous sandy loam soil type encourages water to percolate into subsoils. However vehicular & tractor traffic in wet weather can easily liquify soil and cause noticeable runoff. For this reason a series of French drains was installed during septic field installations (totaling 200 Feet) along contours in 3 locations & functioned as designed through the winter of 2010-2011
