Harold B. Gochnauer, 94, of the Mennonite Home, formerly of West Willow, died June 9, 2008 at Lancaster General Hospital. Born December 20, 1913 in Strasburg, he was a son of the late Adam H. and Myrtle (Bair) Gochnauer. He was preceded in death by his wife, Bell C. (Homsher) Gochnauer.
