

For God, nothing is impossible (Primary School Lunch Club)

Time

About 25 - 30 minutes

Objectives

At the end of the session, the student

1. Will know the story of Jesus and turning water into wine
2. Will know that nothing is impossible for God.
3. Will know that he can come to God with anything, knowing that God can do the impossible.

Key Values

Values to be exercised in this session:

- Communicating Jesus' miracles in an understandable way
- Flexibility when it comes to e.g. act it out or not

Session-Specific Considerations

Be flexible in the story telling and try to let the young people act it out.

Preparation

PLANNING REQUIRED

- Practice handing over to the other team members so that it isn't awkward.

- Jenga

ATTENTION

Story in John 2

Act it out! (If there is enough time and there are enough children)

We need...

... one Jesus

... Jesus' mother

... 2 servants

There was a wedding and the guests had a great time there. But at one point there wasn't any wine left.

Jesus mother told him that and said to the servants that they should do, whatever Jesus told them.

Jesus told them to fill a couple of vases with water.

-> How would you react if someone told you to fill vases with water when there was grape juice needed?

-> Imagine that you were a servant at that time. What would you have done?

Then he turned that water into wine.

-> That seems impossible, does it?

Just like the Jenga tower in the beginning: At some point it was impossible not to knock down the tower.

But with God, nothing is impossible!

-> Luke 18,27 (NCV): "Jesus answered, 'The things impossible for people are possible for God.'" Sometimes we are in a situation that seems impossible (e.g. a very difficult exam). God can work through that and help us. Suddenly we can do the things that seemed impossible at first.

In the next couple of lunch clubs we will talk about more amazing things Jesus did!

APPEAL

The next time when you're in a difficult situation, ask Jesus to help you and remember, that nothing is impossible for him.
