

## John Long Dies; Truck Driver

John H. Long, 54, of 19 Plank Ave., Willow Street, died Monday morning while making a delivery in York.

According to Dr. Charles Hartman, York County coroner, Long was making a delivery for the Mushroom Transportation Co. at the Yesco Electric Co., when he became ill and died at 3:45 a.m.

He had been employed by the Mushroom Transportation Co., formerly Keystone Trucking, for 38 years, and was a member of Teamsters Union 771.

He was a veteran of World War II, having served in the U.S. Army, and was a member of the Willow Street United Church of Christ.

Born in Lancaster, Long was the husband of Florence Ditzler Long and a son of the late Frank and Anna Litch Long.

Besides his widow, he is survived by a son, John H., Jr., Lancaster, a daughter, Deborah Lee Long, at home; three brothers, Theodore Long, Manheim; Robert, and Frank, both of Lancaster, and three sisters, Anna Mary, wife of Franklin Graham, Mrs. Grace Aument, and Mrs. Elizabeth Worrell, all of Lancaster.
