L. Evelyn Smith, 89, Lancaster, PA, changed her permanent residence to Heaven to peacefully be with Her Lord on Sunday, October 26, 2008. Born in Harrisburg, she was the daughter of the late Ralph W. and Lily Mohler Gonder. Evelyn was blessed to enjoy 66 years of marriage to Robert E. Smith, Sr. of Lancaster.

Lovingly she knitted baby blankets for family members and for her mission organizations in third world countries. Many knew her for her oil paintings as well as for her knitting projects which represented the gifts from her heart.
