

Rev. Fahnestock Dies at Age 86

The Rev. Adam G. Fahnestock, 86, of 7 Hilltop Road, Lititz R5, died Thursday at 9:05 p.m. in the General Hospital after an illness of three weeks.

He was active in the Brethren ministry for 59 years and had been ordained in the Church of the Brethren in 1911. He was a charter member and former elder in the Lititz Dunkard Brethren Church.

He operated a general store in Brunnerville until 1938.

The Rev. Mr. Fahnestock obtained patents for a rotary type lawn mower and manufactured them under the name of Kutsall and Trim. He retired from that business in 1959.
