Ruth Hoke Glass, 88, formerly of Valleybrook Drive, Peach Lane, Kreider Avenue, and more recently Mennonite Home Communities, passed away on Friday, September 26th.

Ruth Glass was born May 11th, 1920 to the late Paul E. and Stella J. Hoke in Spring Grove, PA. Following high school, Ruth majored in English at Ursinus College, and graduated in 1942. It was at Ursinus College that Ruth met her husband-to-be, Joseph W. Glass, Jr. Ruth and Joe recently celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary in June.

Married in 1943, Marine service stationed the couple in Corpus Christi, Texas and later, in Southern California. While in Corpus Christi, their first son, Joseph W. III, was born. After her husband's Marine duty, Ruth and Joe returned East, where Joe began his Armstrong World Industries career. The family was soon assigned to Braintree, MA, where their second son, Peter P., was born. A final move back to Armstrong's headquarters in Lancaster preceded the birth of their daughter, Jane T.
