Hilda Marie Plank Ament, wife of the late Miles K. Ament, went to be with Lord on August 21, 2008. She was born on April 1, 1922, to Barbara Tshudy Plank and Diller Plank. Hilda was a graduate of the West Lampeter High School and the Lancaster General Hospital School of Nursing as a Registered Professional Nurse. During World War II, She was a Lieutenant JG with US Navy Nurse Corps. She then worked as a campus nurse at Lehigh University in Bethlehem, PA.

After returning to Lancaster, Mrs. Ament served in numerous volunteer and benevolent capacities. She was a Charter Member and first Vice President of the Lancaster Jane-Cees, auxiliary to the Junior Chamber of Commerce. She was president of XYZ, the American Business Club Auxiliary and a member of the Professional Engineers Auxiliary. Hilda headed the Blind Association project to provide free eye testing to pre-school children, served 6 years on the board of the Lancaster Day Nursery, helped tutor in the Right to Read Program, and also helped in a program for abused children.

For her untiring efforts, she was awarded the Clean Indoor Air Award in 1984.

In Lancaster, she was superintendent of the nursery at St. Andrews United Church of Christ, then assisted as Circle Leader and Co-Chairperson of the women's group at Trinity Lutheran Church. When she moved to Florida, she was an active member of Chapel by the Sea in Ft. Myers, and of Faith Presbyterian Church of Cape Coral. Most recently, she was a member of the Central Congregational Church of Lynn, Mass.
