German rocker Dinger dies at 61

Klaus Dinger, the drummer for the 1970s German band Neu!, whose mechanically repetitive yet buoyant beats had a wide influence in underground rock, died March 20 at age 61.

The cause was heart failure, according to an announcement Wednesday by his German record label, Groenland.

Dinger formed Neu! with guitarist Michael Rother in Duesseldorf in 1971, after both had played in an early incarnation of the group Kraftwerk. Over three albums, the two perfected a droning, hypnotic style made up of Dinger's simple, perpetual-motion rhythms and Rother's fluid guitar effects.

Exemplified in songs like the 10-minute "Hallogallo," Dinger's beat was a steady pulse that seemed to extend rock's most basic rhythmic patterns infinitely. The beat came to be known as Motorik, an allusion to the industrial style then prevalent among German groups.
