The founder of Owogram.com gets over about 100k visits every month without spending any dime on an advertisement, and he's making cool cash every month.



People use the road to move from home to office, school, market, business places, meetings, village, religious events in fact the list is long.


Going into transport business in Nigeria is a viable proposition since business is growing each day with the growing number of population in the country. Starting this unique business will definitely return handsome profit.



In 2014, it was estimated that 268 million tons of cassava were produced globally. Interestingly, Cassava is the third-largest source of food carbohydrates in the tropics, after rice and maize.

Cassava is used for producing common food products in Nigeria like garri, flour, tapioca, fufu, chips, etc. It is rich in vitamins, carbs, calcium, etc.

There is a ready market for cassava and its farming is not very labor-intensive like some other food crops. After harvesting, the stem will be used again for the next planting.
