Charles W. (Bill, 3-Tours) Sultzbach, Jr., 61, of Wrightsville, died Saturday, December 6, 2008 in Wrightsville as a result of injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident.

Born November 18, 1947, in Lancaster, he was the son of Anna (Rockey) Sultzbach and the late Charles W. Sultzbach, Sr. He was married to Grace E. (Klugh) Sultzbach on May 7, 1993.

A Veteran of the Vietnam War, Charles proudly served with the US Marine Corps. He was a decorated veteran and a Purple Heart recipient.

Bill had been a truck driver prior to becoming disabled due to post-traumatic stress disorder. He was a member of the Vietnam Vets Motorcycle Club, a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, Marine Corps League, MBA and the American Legion.

In 2004, Charles went to Martin Kondor's Funeral. He felt the need to go. He said, "I'm Marines and he's Army, but that doesn't matter. We're brothers."

A devoted family man, Bill had a big heart that was willing to help anyone who needed it.

He is survived by his wife, Grace E. Sultzbach, of Wrightsville; a daughter, Kimberly, of FL; two sons, Terence R. and Chance H. Sultzbach, both of Wrightsville; his mother, Anna; a sister, Sandy; a brother, David, all of FL; a brother, Charles, of Lancaster; a step-daughter, Tabitha Klugh, of NJ; a step-son, Christopher Martin of Harrisburg and three grandchildren as well as his extended family and caring friends.
